



POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTERS

The following are guidelines for poster presentations at the Nature Based Coastal Solutions and Ecological Restoration (NBCS-ERS) 2024.

Poster Guidelines:

- Maximum poster size is 44" by 44"W (112 cm x 112 cm) on standard paper to be pinned to a poster board.
- Pins will be provided to affix posters to posterboards.
- Use easily read type. Suggested minimum font sizes:
 - Title: 56pt
 - Authors, Sub-headings: 36pt
 - Body text: 24pt
 - Captions: 18pt
- Sans-serif fonts are recommended to improve accessibility.
- Choose colours to provide strong contrast and avoid pairing red and green elements to assist those with red-green colour impairments.
- Print a high-resolution copy of your poster to present onsite.
- Please also have in pdf format.

Each poster will be assigned a number corresponding to a pin-up space on poster boards in the poster display area, to be communicated to presenters in the weeks leading up to the NBCS-ERS. Posters will be displayed June 23rd-26th. Poster presenters are asked to be present at their posters in the poster display area to explain and discuss their posters with conference delegates during the poster session and public expo from 5:00 – 7:00 pm on Tuesday June 25th.

The poster display area is in Loyola Conference Hall (L290), in the Loyola Academic Complex.

Confirm your attendance at NBCS-ER Symposium by registering no later than May 24th or your poster may be cancelled.
