A parcel of land between Onslow Road and Salmon River is being restored to a tidal wetland to reduce local flood risk and recover important wildlife habitat. Restoration will begin in 2021 with the breaching of the old dyke

## What to Expect

Tidal wetland habitat recovery is a multi-year process. Before wetland vegetation is established, existing plants will die and land will become muddy.
